## ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



### Morning Time

When you go into your child’s room, say: “Good morning! Where’s [child’s name] that God made? I’m so glad God made you.”



### Drive Time

While on the go, ask your child: “What are some things we do to stay safe?” (Hold my hand in the store or crossing the street, put away our toys so we don’t trip over them, etc.)



### Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: “God, thank You for making [child’s name] and thank You for making me.”



### Bath Time

As you give your child a bath, say: “God made David good at protecting so David could protect his sheep.”
